

*SEARCHING FOR LYGIA CLARK'S TRACE, Memory and Evocation of the Paris years

SUR LES TRACES DE LYGIA CLARK Souvenirs et évocations de ses années parisiennes

The film tells, through the memory of five participants, the experiences in the classroom "the gesture communication", held by Lygia Clark, the Brazilian artist University of Sorbonne in Paris between 1970 and 1975.

Through the testimony of five participants, tracked in France, who attended the course, the guidelines of the lessons are proposed to the viewer. Their testimonies accompanying the reconstruction of super 8 in a few moments of his experiences as a kind of collective ritual. Relying on their memories and watching the few precious pictures and footage remained, respondents recall and recount the moments and situations that are characteristic of that experienced intense situations. Words reminiscent of the twisted wire, there are also a series of visions that they stage the sensory and perceptual pathways.
